Evaluation of benefits/impacts on 50 students participating in the project STVN:

I PROFESSIONAL KNOWLEDGE:

1 Describe contribution of your involvement in the project to your **professional knowledge, skills**. What new information have you got, what have you learned?

Answers: We have learned how to handle with a camera, write script, edit videos, create logos, write commentaries, prepare and make interviews, use a new programme Adobe Premier, add audio track to a video. Also, make presentations to a public, principles of writing articles in journalistic club, outline of the writing based on principles – who, what, where, why. Making short videos in international teams enabled us mutual cooperation, creation.

2 Have you improved your **language and communicative skills**? Name ways of communication you used during work in the project.

Answers: We have improved these skills a lot because the project is based on communication. We spoke to foreigners all the time during study exchange, in workshops, during evening activities. We continue communication via Facebook. Also, we presented presentations about our countries, make interviews, wrote commentaries to the videos, articles on the web, translated some texts into mother tongues and English. We were motivated to improve our English. Some students admitted they overcame their shyness, they were made to communicate.

Participants appreciated lessons in hosts tongues and use some basic vocabulary – greetings, polite phrases.

3 Has the project made, motivated you to **study on your own**? What have you learned?

Answers: We have improved knowledge of editing videos, use flash, programme Photoshop, Work with videos, new ideas to learn about, we are motivated to learn more – to be better than our partners.

4 Has the project work improved your **personality** – reliability, responsibility, ability to work in a team?

Answers: Yes, we have learned to complete tasks in our free time on time, work in a team with others, do activities together, be more open to people, improved organization skills. Also, we admired Romanians polite behaviour and the way girls put on their dresses.
